Children's Program (age 3-12) Rooms, Nursery Rooms, and Cafeteria are all in the Unistructure. Please see map and pictures below.

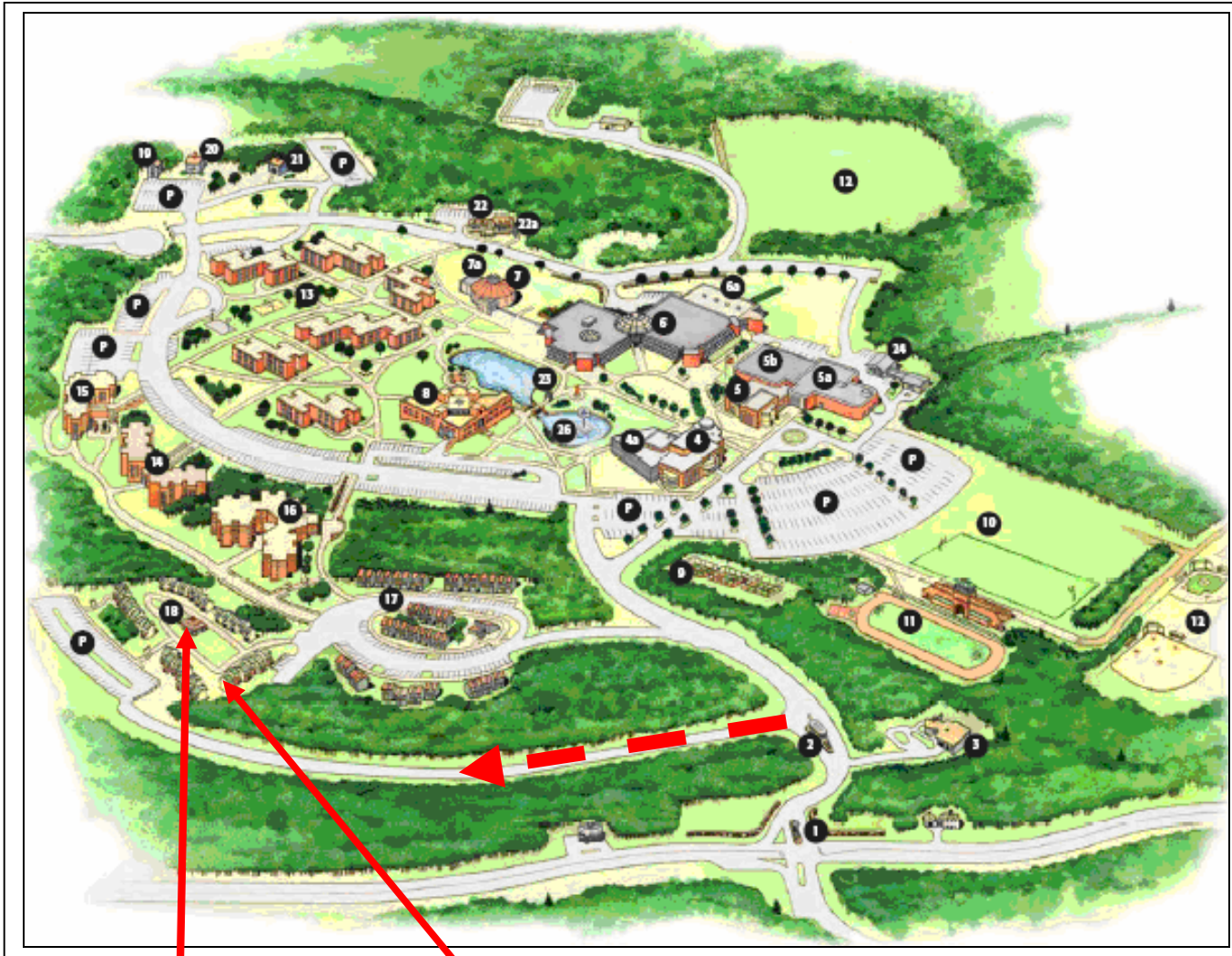
Physical Exercises:

Directions to Bryant University

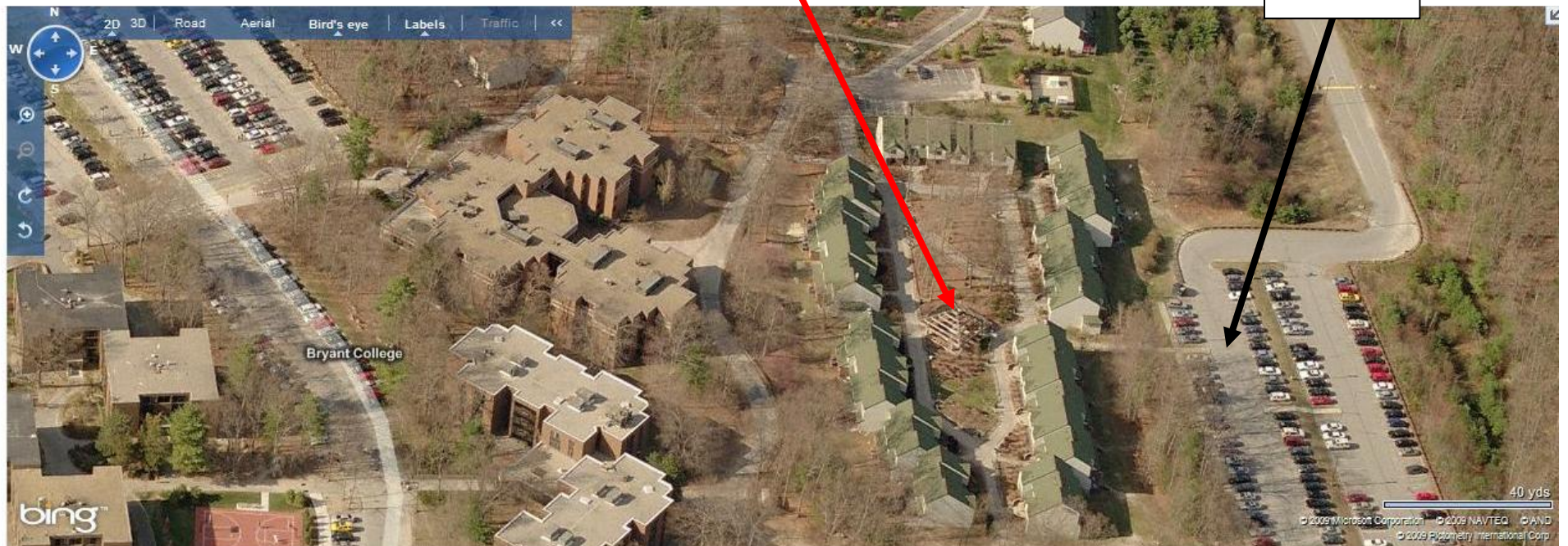
From Boston, Massachusetts

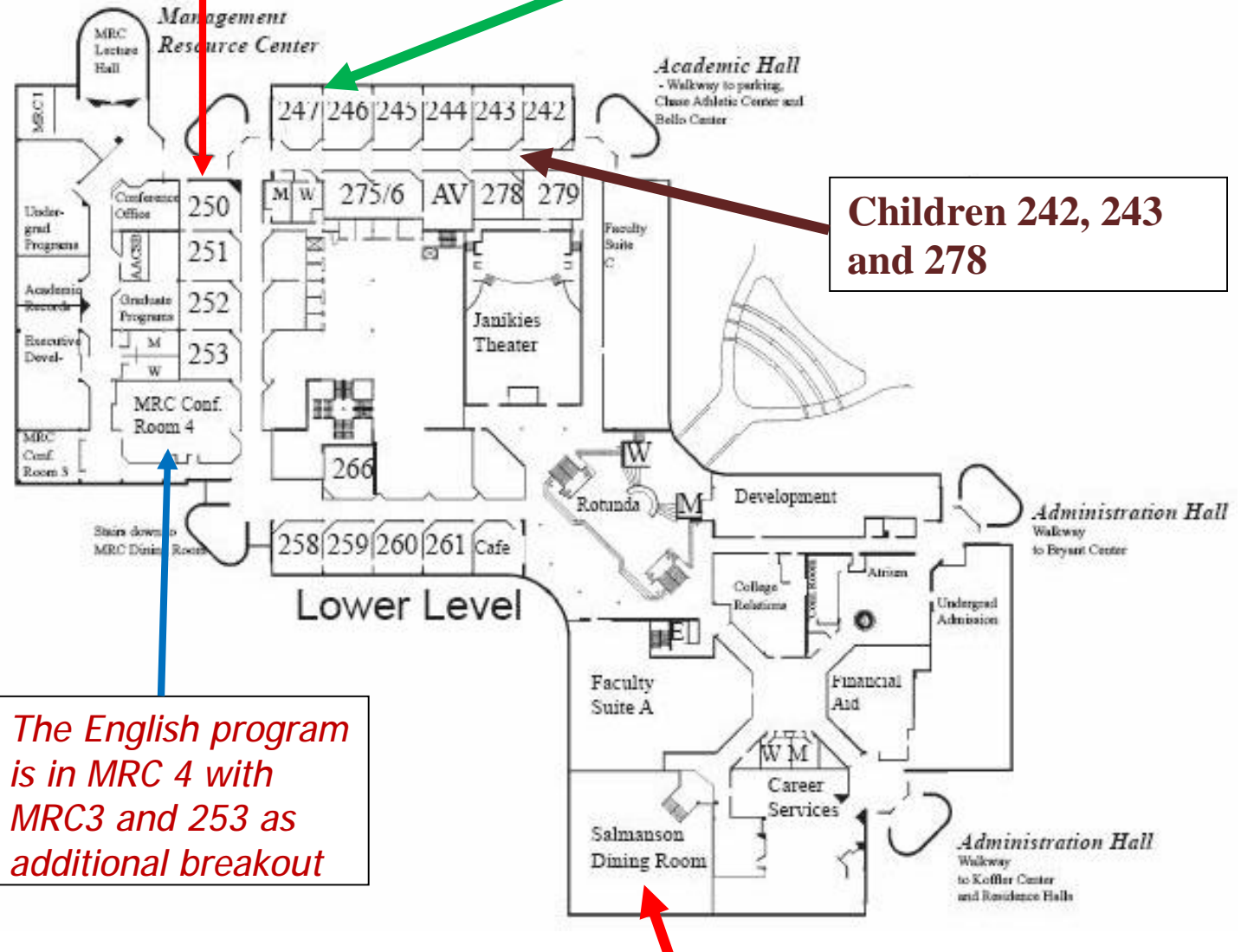
